Role	Scenario Card 1
retired teacher	I have yard work to do, but since I hurt my ankle, I can't do it. I pay my neighbor to do some of my yard work.
neighbor	I get paid for my hard work. I walk to the bank and deposit my money into my account. I am saving for something important.
bank teller	I deposit people's money into their accounts. After work, I am going to the public library. I pay \$2 to take the city bus to the library. I know fees and tax dollars pay for government services like buses and libraries.
librarian	I work at the public library, which is paid for by taxes. I have been saving my money so that I can go to a concert. I will buy a ticket today.
band manager	The band wants to give back to the city for a great concert. I am giving some profits to a charity.

Money Moves Scenario Cards



Role	Scenario Card 2
band manager	I pay a recording studio to record a new album.
recording studio owner	I pay the sound engineer for working with the band.
sound engineer	I receive pay for my work. I take my paycheck to the bank and deposit it into my account
bank teller	I deposit the money into the correct account. After work, I drive over a bridge to go home. I pay a toll to cross the bridge. Fees and taxes support bridges and roads.
Public Works Department worker	After a day of paving roads and fixing potholes, I walk home. On my way, I pass Girl Scouts selling cookies, I give them \$2 from my wallet to support their activities.

Role	Scenario Card 3
hair stylist	I pay a fee to renew my hair-cutting license. The money goes to the city government to help pay for city services.
city bookkeeper	I collect fees and taxes. I collect fees and taxes. I use that money to pay the city workers, like the road engineer.
road engineer	I received my paycheck today for helping design a new bridge. I take my paycheck to the bank and deposit it into my account.
bank teller	I deposit the money into people's accounts. When I get home, I buy some music from my favorite band.
band manager	The band gives money to the local school so that students can get some new instruments.

Role	Scenario Card 4
band manager	There is going to be a concert downtown. I convince the band members to give some concert profits to the food pantry to help people who don't have enough food to eat each day.
director of the food pantry	The city government helps pay for the food pantry using money from taxes. After stocking shelves with food donations that came in today, I walk to the bookstore to buy a few books to read.
cashier at the bookstore	I get paid \$35 for a day's work. On payday, I deposit my money in the bank. I want to buy a wonderful present for my parents, but I don't have enough money yet.
parent	I go to the Motor Vehicles Department and pay a fee to get my driver's license. Like my tax money, my driver's license fee goes to the government. Taxes and fees help pay for city services like the fire department and police.
firefighter	I know how important fire trucks are, so I give money to the fire station. The fire department is collecting money to buy a new fire truck.

Role	Scenario Card 5
customer	I am eating lunch at a restaurant with my friend. We just came from the concert downtown. It was awesome! We pay for our food.
restaurant owner	Once a year, I give money to the Children's Hospital to help treat children whose families don't have enough money for medical care.
doctor at the Children's Hospital	After work each day, I pay \$5 to take the subway home. Fees and tax dollars help pay for the subway system and other city services like trash collection, parks, and teachers.
teacher	Every Friday night, I pay to take my family to the movies.
movie ticket salesperson	I get paid \$35 for a day's work. I take my paycheck to the bank and deposit it into my bank account.

Role	Scenario Card 6
restaurant owner	I hire my favorite band to bring in more customers.
band manager	I buy new outfits for the band members from the clothing store at the mall.
clothing store worker	I get my paycheck every week. Each week, I deposit my money into my bank account. I want to buy a bike, but I don't have enough money yet. Until then, I will have to take the city bus, which is free for students since tax dollars help keep buses running in the city.
bus driver	I really like animals. Once a month, I give \$10 to the animal shelter.
veterinarian	I take care of cats and dogs in the shelter. Once a week, I go to my favorite restaurant. I hear that this week my favorite band will be playing. I may buy dessert!
