

JA Our City Errata Sheet

Session 1:

- **That's Life! Game Mismatch:** Some of the scenarios have been updated since the guidebook was printed. Please see below for the specific changes, with the bolded text highlighting the updates.
 - *Extra chores mean **\$20.00** extra money. (earn, money going in)*
 - *You break a lamp playing in the house and have to buy a new one for **\$20.00**. (buy, money going out)*
 - Replacing mini golf example; **Give \$10.00 to a local animal shelter.** (give, time going out)

Session 2:

- **Junior Journal & Slides Discrepancy:** The Junior Journal chart and the online slides for the "Many Ways to Play" activity don't match exactly. The Junior Journal has been adjusted to allow space for students to take notes on how each payment category works.
- **Vocabulary Error:** Please note on page 2 of the Junior Journal for session two that the correct term in the word bank is "goods," not "gifts," in the vocabulary section.

Session 4:

- **Save the City Activity:**
 - The goal of this game is to help balance the city's choices with money. Ask students what they think would happen if a city and its people spent all their money without saving any. What might happen if the city saved all its money and didn't spend any? Discuss with students how important it is to plan and balance spending, saving, and even donating money, both for a city and for a personal budget.
 - The QR codes have been fixed – in the event they aren't working, please use the links provided in the volunteer guidebook instead.
- **Money Moves in the City Activity:**
 - The goal of this activity is for students to see examples of how taxes, spending, and income are interconnected within a city. The Junior Journal page is for students to listen and keep track of each time they hear an example of earn/save/buy/give.
